- *How to use the online version of the Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI-2) to gather pre and post program outcome data.

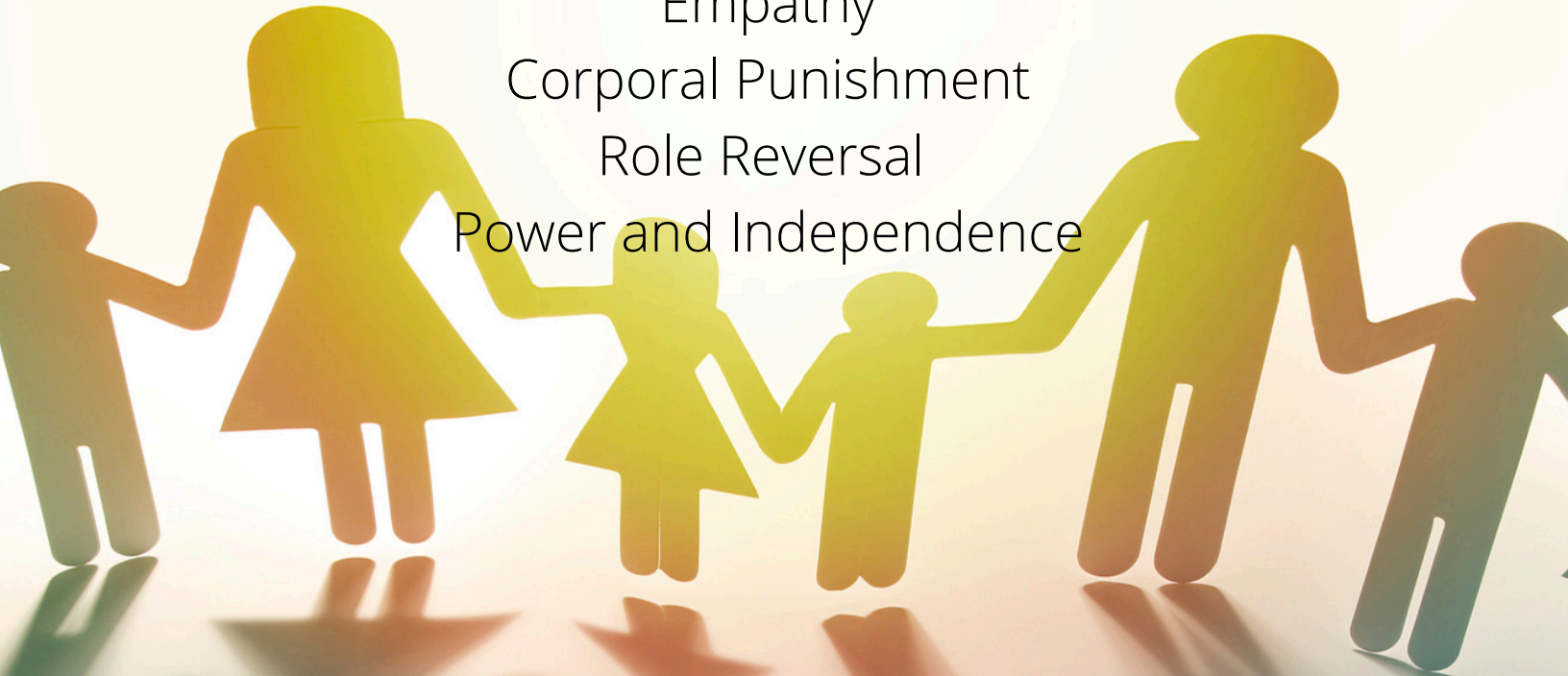
